**CONFESSION OF FAITH:** Questions 66 and 81 of the Heidelberg Catechism

**Q. *What are sacraments?***

*A. Sacraments are holy signs and seals for us to see. They were instituted by God so that by our use of them he might make us understand more clearly the promise of the gospel, and might put his seal on that promise. And this is God's gospel promise: to forgive our sins and give us eternal life because of Christ's one sacrifice finished on the cross.*

**Q. *Who are to come to the Lord's Table?***

*A. Those who are displeased with themselves because of their sins, but who nevertheless trust that their sins are pardoned and that their continuing weakness is covered by the suffering and death of Christ, and who also desire more and more to strengthen their faith and to lead a better life. Hypocrites and those who are unrepentant, however, eat and drink judgment on themselves.*
